YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the State Finance Committee of the state of Washington (the "Committee"), acting by and through the State Treasurer, at the Office of the State Treasurer, Legislative Building, Second Floor, Room 230, Olympia, commencing at approximately 11:30 AM, on the 23rd day of January, 2013, will consider for approval the following proposed Bond Sale Resolutions:

1. Resolution No. 1138 awards the sale of \$551,910,000, more or less, of State of Washington Various Purpose General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series R-2013C, as authorized by Resolution No. 1116, as amended by Resolution No. 1137 of the Committee, and Chapters 39.42 and 39.53 RCW.
2. Resolution No. 1139 awards the sale of \$125,360,000, more or less, of State of Washington Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series R-2013D, as authorized by Resolution No. 1116, as amended by Resolution No. 1137 of the Committee, and Chapters 39.42 and 39.53 RCW.
3. Resolution No. 1140 awards the sale of \$230,580,000, more or less, of State of Washington Various Purpose General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013D, as authorized by Resolutions Nos. 1114 and 1128 of the Committee, Chapter 14, Laws of 1989, 1st Ex. Sess.; Chapter 15, Laws of 1990, 1st Ex. Sess.; Ch. 147, Laws of 2003; Chapter 167, Laws of 2006; Chapter 498, Laws of 2009; Chapter 49, Laws of 2011, 1st Sp. Sess.; Chapter 1, Laws of 2012, 2nd Sp. Sess.; and Chapter 39.42 RCW.
3. Resolution No. 1141 awards the sale of \$323,450,000, more or less, of State of Washington Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013E, as authorized by Resolution No. 1115 of the Committee, Chapter 321, Laws of 1998 (Referendum 49 (RCW 47.10.843)); Chapter 147, Laws of 2003 (RCW 47.10.861); Chapter 315, Laws of 2005 (RCW 47.10.873); and Chapter 39.42 RCW.

The results of the foregoing bond sales will be posted on the State Treasurer's website promptly following approval of the Bond Sale Resolution by the State Treasurer on behalf of the Committee.
