**Deposit Limitations:**

- Governmental entities may deposit funds in any Washington State branch of public depositories listed. Total deposits by any one depositor in any one credit union may not exceed the maximum amount insured by the national credit union share insurance fund per RCW 39.58.240. Certificates of deposit are negotiable only between treasurers and /or public depositories.
